You may wonder, if each Saint has a feast day, why do we then celebrate All Saints Day? In the book of Revelation, John describes heaven in this way: After that I saw a huge number, impossible to count, of people from every nation, race, tribe and language; they were standing in front of the throne and in front of the Lamb, dressed in white robes and holding palms in their hands. They shouted aloud, 'Victory to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!' Rev 7:9-10. This suggests that everyone who has conquered death and is now in Heaven deserves recognition, and we celebrate them on this day. We ask them for their help and intercession to become Saints and friends of God.
