<u>Proposed Controlled Parking Zone</u> Greenford South

Ealing Council is proposing a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) in Greenford South and Greenford Town Centre. As most of you are already aware, the church carpark is fully utilized during school time in order to accommodate both the Visitation Primary school and Cardinal Wiseman Secondary school staff. This means that those who come for funerals, weddings and other church services during the week rely heavily on parking on streets in the nearby area. Additionally, as there are limited spaces in the church carpark, many of the school staff have to park on the street during school time. Therefore, the Council's proposal would cause significant cost and disruption to both church services and school staff.

Meeting with Ministers of the Word

The Lectionary, which is the book that contains the Scripture readings for Mass and the Sacraments,

is changing as part of the continuing process of revising liturgical translations. The process began with the Roman Missal in 2011 and has continued with all the other liturgical texts. The new Lectionary will use the English Standard Version - Catholic Edition of the Bible. The changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, biblical scholarship, and to provide a text for use in liturgical setting that is more proclaimable and, where inclusive. The new appropriate, more lectionary volumes will be used from 1st Sunday of Advent 2024 in all dioceses in England and Wales.

To aid Ministers of the Word with these changes we will meet with them after each of the Masses THIS weekend. Please come into the sacristy directly after Mass.

Scam Emails Targeting Parishioners

The ICT department of the Dioceses of Westminster have informed us of the rise of scam emails targeting parishioners. These emails impersonate the parish priest, often using a similar email name and masking the real email address. They typically request the recipient to purchase Amazon or other gift cards as gifts for the priest.

Unfortunately, we have received reports of parishioners falling victim to these scams, with some individuals losing up to £600 to the fraudsters.
