Feast of St. Vincent Pallotti



The feast day for St. Vincent Pallotti will be on Wednesday 22nd January. Please join us for the opening of the Holy Door, a healing service and blessing with the relic of St Vincent beginning at 11:30am followed by Mass at 12:30. After Mass all are invited to the Cardinal Wiseman school for lunch. The Novena to St Vincent Pallotti will begin on Monday 13th January at the 12.00 noon Mass.

Holy Door

As part of our feast day celebrations during this Jubilee year we will officially open the Holy Door in our church. The Holy Door is deemed 'Holy' since it calls all those who enter through it to walk in holiness of life. Crossing this threshold also symbolises the journey of conversion, sealed by the encounter with Christ, the "door", uniting us with the Father. The Jubilees are part of a profound history of faith that opens its doors to the world—a journey in which the people of God walk together along the paths of forgiveness.

During this Jubilee year you can obtain a plenary indulgence by making a pilgrimage to Westminster Cathedral or to Our Lady of the Visitation on the 22nd of each month and passing through the Holy Door. The Indulgence can be obtained here by devoutly participating in Holy Mass, reciting the Stations of the Cross, or the Holy Rosary. Alternatively you can, for a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with the Our Father, the Profession of Faith in any legitimate form, and invocations to Mary, the Mother of God, so that in this Holy Year everyone "will come to know the closeness of Mary, the most affectionate of mothers, who never abandons her children".

Novena Prayer to St. Vincent Pallotti

Almighty and ever living God, you glorified Vincent Pallotti and made him a powerful intercessor in heaven. We come before you with our petitions and place before you all our needs and cares. Trusting in your divine providence, we place ourselves like Vincent Pallotti in your loving care seeking your protection.

O God of all consolations, have compassion on all those who suffer and are in need.
