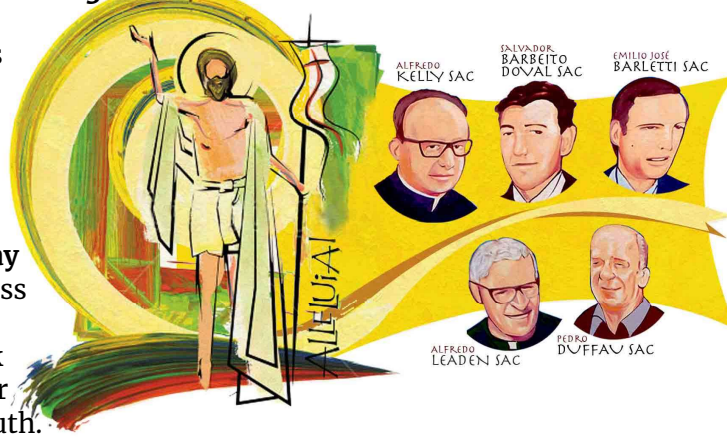

### Pallottine Five Argentina

On July 4, 1976, amid Argentina's "Dirty War," five members of the Pallottine community—three priests and two seminarians—were brutally murdered at St. Patrick's Parish in Buenos Aires. Their lives of faith, service, and commitment to justice continue to inspire the Church today. Next weekend we will commemorate the 50th anniversary of their martyrdom by **all night Adoration of from 5pm Friday 3rd July to 12 noon Saturday 4th**, finishing with a Mass for peace. On Sunday we will show a presentation by Fr John O'Connor SAC at each Mass. During this week we remember their witness to the Gospel and pray for peace, reconciliation, and the courage to stand for truth.
